



Genesis 3

God knows sin differently than each of us:

The Law

The tree of the knowledge of good and evil is a picture of the law.

The tree of the knowledge of good and evil is a good thing, just like the law.

God did not give the law for man to live by and make him holy.

God gave us the law to show us a standard we could never live up to on our own.



The Law

Romans 3:20 - Therefore no one will be declared righteous in God's sight by the works of the law; rather, through the law we become conscious of our sin.

i.e. Someone can jump 8ft and I might be able to meet that standard, but if the standard is the height of a rooftop then I will never be able to make it.



The Law

The law is written to point out your sin so you can repent.

When you have the knowledge of sin you feel condemnation because you can't reach God's level of holiness.

Doing good works doesn't mean you know Jesus.



2 Corinthians 3:7-9

Now if the ministry that brought death, which was engraved in letters on stone, came with glory, so that the Israelites could not look steadily at the face of Moses because of its glory, transitory though it was, will not the ministry of the Spirit be more glorious? If the ministry that brought condemnation was glorious, how much more glorious if the ministry that brings righteousness!



The devil's tactics

1) He's smart/crafty/cunning

- His name is Satan which means prosecutor/accuser of the law.
- The prosecutor's job is to condemn why the person is guilty.

2) He will whisper a little lie for you to say.

- Primary tactic: "Why would you tell a lie like that?"
- Primary job: To hang out the dirty laundry.



The devil's tactics

3) Use the word of God to twist it against someone

- If you have experiences the New Covenant the devil will try to take you back to Old.
- If you haven't, he will try to keep you in the Old Covenant.
